# TWO EVENTS OF INTEREST: 1) THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON GEOETHICS 2) GEOLOGICAL AND COSMIC RISKS

Both events will be arranged (as a series with one common session) in the framework of the MINING PŘÍBRAM SYMPOSIUM 2013: the Conference accordingly to the International Declaration of Geoethics agreed on behalf of the AGID Working Group for Geoethics at the end of the traditional international section on GEOETHICS hosted by the Symposium in October 2011, the event sub 2 as the international section of the Symposium co-sponsored by the AGID with a new topic (in case of an increased number of papers the start of the event sub 2 will be probably shifted to PRAGUE, Saturday October 12, 2013). The participation at the Conference is open to any person interested in the topics. The event sub 1 will cover a special session on geoethical problems concerning the well known L'AQUILA CASE (earthquake and process), the event sub 2 will include also ASPECTS OF NANOTECHNOLOGY. Because of the new elements of the meeting the deadline for submitting abstracts and (pre)registration form has been prolonged until April 30.

All suggestions with topics related to geoethics and geological and cosmic risks will be accepted either for a regular oral presentation or for a short communication, rarely as a poster. Your replies in the registration forms (p. 4) prior to April 30, 2013 will be appreciated in order to prepare the optimum version of the program. For those already pre-registered not necessary to renew this registration. All potential participants will be asked to send the FINAL REGISTRATION FORM (issued in May 2013).

The COMMON tradition of all 3 organisations goes back to the years 1991-1992 (as interpreted in the web sites of AGID and IAGETH – see below) and it is inseparably linked with traditional international meetings at Příbram and International Geological Congresses (both since 1992). Since 2004 (IGC Florence) geoethics have been taken under the umbrella of AGID – especially in the very active AGID Working Group of Geoethics. The identical roots of the IAPG can be followed in the history, since 2010 supported by the guidance of the AGID Past President Dr. Shrikant Limaye (presently keeping the position of the IAPG Vice-president). In the opinion of the editor the real difference among the new associations seems to be in their relation to the L'Aquila earthquake and process. Let us hope that the presence of the top representatives of all 3 associations in Vienna (EGU 2013) will help to make the goals, distinctions and co-operation clear enough.
